SPEAKERS:

Chris Apgar, CISSP; President, Apgar & Assoc., LLC, Portland, Oregon. With more than nineteen years experience in regulatory compliance, Chris is considered one of the country's foremost experts and spokespersons on healthcare privacy, security, regulatory affairs, state and federal compliance, and secure and efficient electronic health information exchange.

Brett Emry, RN, WCC, DFCC is a wound care nurse at Samaritan Albany General Hospital, Albany, Oregon. Brett works with coders to provide insight regarding wound debridement procedures and ostomy care.

Karen Halverson, RHIT, Coding Auditor, Legacy Health System, Portland, Oregon. Karen has thirty-five years coding experience and comes with a wealth of knowledge to share from her experiences as a coding auditor/trainer at LHS.

Judi Hofman, CAP, CHP, CHSS. Judi is a privacy and information security officer for a three hospital health system in central Oregon. Judi also works at the state level with Oregon Association of Health and Hospital System HIPAA/Compliance Task Force and with the Oregon & S.W. Washington Healthcare Privacy & Security Forum. She has presented at the AHIMA National conference, IT Security World Conference, and HIPAA Security Summit.

Joe Rivet is Coding Auditor for Hall, Render, Killian, Heath & Lyman in Troy, Michigan. He has extensive experience in physician and emergency department professional and facility coding and has expertise in evaluation and management auditing. He has taught intensive coding courses to physicians and coders nationwide. His experiences bring an in-depth understanding of Medicare regulations related to physician documentation and billing. Mr. Rivet is a Certified Professional Coder, Certified Evaluation and Management Coder, Certified Coding Specialist – Physician Based, Certified Internal Controls Auditor and Certified Professional Medical Auditor.

Carol Robinson is Oregon’s State HIT Coordinator and the Director of the Health Information Technology Oversight Council (HITOC). HITOC is charged with coordinating Oregon's public and private statewide efforts in electronic health records adoption and the development of a statewide system for electronic health information exchange. Prior to her current role, Robinson served as the Interim Executive Director of the Oregon Health Fund Board during the 2009 Legislative Session, working to enact the Health Fund Board’s recommendations through the passage of HB2009.

Justin Wilcox is Chief Technical Officer for Nimbus Health in Seattle, Washington. After serving as an engineer and engineering lead on the Windows operating system, Justin left Microsoft in 2008 to start Nimbus Health, a software company driven to help HIM departments securely release medical records online.
